

# Kindermusik at Felician Village

Take Note Studio began teaching Kindermusik classes at Felician Village on March 8. Kindermusik lets children through age seven explore music through moving, singing, and playing instruments. A rich variety of activities promote music and language development, symbolic thinking, coordination, and social interaction.

Felician Village residents will now have the opportunity to attend these classes on our campus. Music helps with language, brain development and encourages motor development for children, but also for seniors. For example, grasping and shaking bells, egg shakers and other simple musical instruments helps to develop fine motor skills or learning to keep a steady beat may help with balance, coordination and self-confidence. Music also provides stimulation which may get limbs moving and blood circulating to all parts of the body - including the brain.

However, it is not just about the music for the residents, it is about building relationships, feeling a sense of belonging and spending time



with young children. It's a chance for residents to see a new world through the eyes of a child.

Classes are scheduled for March 8th through May 17th and June 14th until August 16th from 5:45pm-6:30pm in the Village Hall.
