Walk to End ALZ

Join Team Felician Village as we lead the way to a world without Alzheimer's on a 2 mile walk **Saturday, September 17**, on Mariner's Trail. On-site registration starts at the Manitowoc-Two Rivers YMCA at 8:30 a.m., with the opening ceremony at 9:40 a.m. and the walk immediately following.

How to register for the walk...

Go to alz.org/walk and select Team Felician Village or contact Debbie Pitsch, Volunteer Coordinator, for assistance with the registration. The team goal is to have 20 walkers with each walker raising a minimum of \$50.00. Walkers raising \$100 or more will receive an official Walk to End Alzheimer's t-shirt. (Note: You don't need to collect donations to participate in the walk). All funds raised further the care, support and research efforts of the Alzheimer's Association.

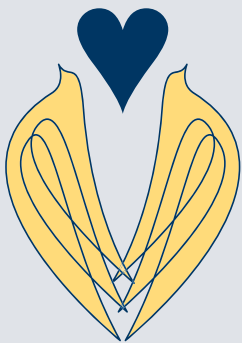

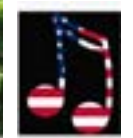

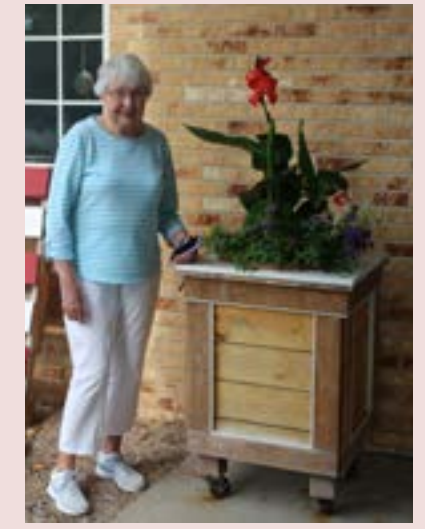


Lunch Bunch

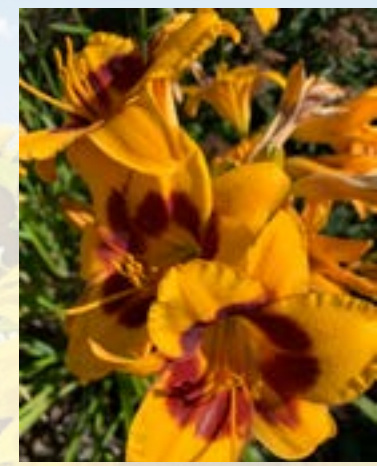

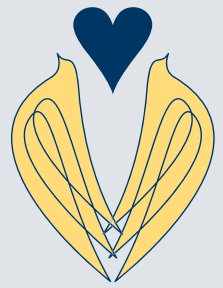
