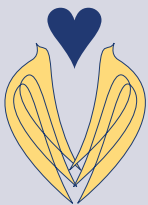

Aloha, Ohana! What a FANTASTIC Family Fest!

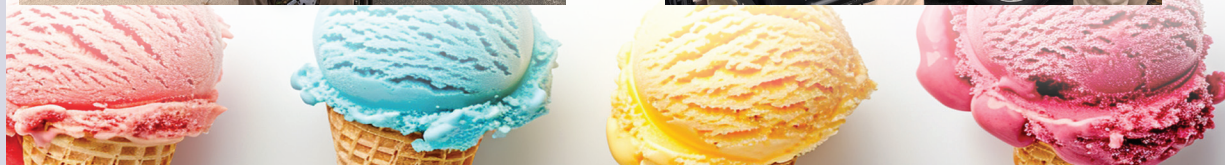

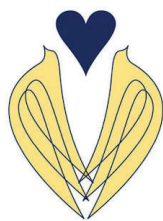

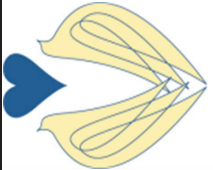
